Why we do what we do

SNIPSA partners with many area shelters to save dogs and cats facing euthanasia. In fact, we have done this over 15,000 times. Mange, heartworm disease, fractures, parvo, and nursing mothers are just some of the issues we manage. So when we received a photo of a hairless, emaciated, and severely neglected dog we said "yes, of course!"

Missing most if not all of his hair, his leathered skin was sizzling red and oozed with infection. He scratched with such intensity he needed an E-collar to prevent further damage. It wasn't

the double dewclaws on his rear paws that we discovered he was a Great Pyrenees.

Luck was on his side when a veterinarian stepped up to foster. Mufassa would require weeks of antibiotics, medicated baths, and "super" foods. He was half his body size weighing just 48 lbs. With commitment and time, the transformation began. Small tufts of fur sprouted, the infection resolved, and the skeleton of a body disappeared. Eight weeks later, weighing in at 92 lbs., Mufassa has landed himself in a forever home where he surfs the ground for fallen goldfish and claims his bed on the family sofa.





Andy's new heartbeat.

Did you know that a dog can need a pacemaker, too? Although it's not very common, they are sometimes a necessary lifesaving measure.

Just like human hearts, canine hearts can develop heart failure. This means that the heart can't pump adequate oxygen to the rest of the body. Andy is a fortunate SNIPSA rescue dog who made the trip to Texas A&M Veterinary School in an effort to kick-start his heart. After thorough testing, veterinary cardiologists determined this lucky canine was a candidate for the procedure. Doctors carefully threaded the small pacemaker device into his heart. The battery that powers it was placed under the skin in his neck. Today, Andy requires medication and can't wear a traditional leash as it could damage his battery pack, but he is a typical fun-loving pup who enjoys a daily standoff with the resident cat and greets his foster family with a never-ending tail wag. This is just one example of SNIPSA's huge heart — our folks invest soul, time, tenacity, and pocketbook into making a positive difference in the life of every pet that passes through our doors. • • • • • • • •
