SNIPSA is an organization formed by a group of veterinarians and caring individuals dedicated to helping homeless and unwanted animals in San Antonio and the surrounding area. SNIPSA does not have a standing shelter and depends on a core group of volunteers to foster and rehabilitate animals in their homes. This provides us with the opportunity to learn first hand about the animal's needs and behavior in order to facilitate an appropriate adoption. SNIPSA was incorporated in 2006 and has rehomed more than 17,000 animals. The SNIPSA mission is fourfold: to Rescue, Rehabilitate, and ReHome adoptable animals from high kill shelters and the community, and to encourage responsibility within the pet owning population. By providing rescue, adoption, and offering low cost spay/neuter options, we are able to connect with our community and enrich the lives of our pet population.

WHY AN ART GALLERY INSIDE A VETERINARY HOSPITAL?

The Greller Gallery at STVO is located at 503 E. Sonterra Blvd on the second floor inside a large veterinary referral facility. This 19,000 square foot, state-of-the-art hospital provides specialized care in veterinary ophthalmology, surgery, internal medicine, oncology, critical care, physical rehabilitation, radiology (on-site ultrasound, CT and MRI) and neurology.

Dr. Andrew Greller's practice, South Texas Veterinary Ophthalmology (STVO), is located within the hospital and is connected to the Greller Gallery at STVO. Dr. Greller and his wife, Faryl, believe art within a health care setting, combined with outstanding medical care, creates an ambiance that encourages healing and comfort, elevates the spirit and affirms hope.
